01/09/15 **Minutes of the last meeting**

Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 14th July 2015 agreed and proposed as accurate by Cllr Palfreyman. Seconded by Cllr Harris and signed as correct

02/09/15 **Matters Arising**

Defibrillator – Cllrs received written feedback from Jonathan Morgan (Flagg resident) stating that there had been offers of donations in excess of the likely cost of the unit. Funding may also be available from the BHF (British Heart Foundation). Mr Morgan is still looking into options for specific units and will feedback at the November meeting.

EE – the possibility off EE providing signal booster boxes within the village is progressing slowly. EE is working with Jonathan Morgan to look for possible sites, preferably on commercial rather than residential premises.

Pipers Yard – One tender had been received for Pipers Yard from Cllr Naylor. In Cllr Naylor's absence Cllr's agreed to accept this tender and payment had been received (cheque for £50).

Parish Croft – the croft at the bottom of the village opposite Lomas' farm is not presently being used. LM to ask Flagg Nursery School is they wish to use it for Forest Schools. Note, there are no toilet facilities.

Action: LM to contact Flagg Nursery School.

A cheque for £50 has been received for the tender of Pipers Yard.

A letter has been received notifying the Parish Council that DDDC will be issuing an invoice for services rendered during the Parish election. The amount of this invoice is unknown.
