A resident has asked if the PC is able to assist on the consultation with regard to reducing the village bus service.

Action: LM to contact saying that there is not much of a service, but it would be detrimental to lose all provision. It would be beneficial to have a more usable service – buses at sensible times to and from Buxton/Bakewell.

Any Other Business

Cllr Harris commented on the number and severity of potholes around the village and surrounding roads/lanes. Specifically:

- there are many deep and wide potholes in the road from Lomas' to Harris'
- from Lomas' to the end of the village
- a subsided pothole on main road outside nursery where there was an access hole dug by Severn Trent Water but poorly filled
- on main road at the bottom of Chestnut House's drive (opposite Highfield Farm)
- top of main road opposite Edge Close Farm
